and in case that the yearly payment shall prove insufficient for  
her maintenance which shall be in like & stead of her dozen or third  
of my estate, I do charge my estate both Real & personal be payments  
legacies and accommodations apportioned.

112. I nominate & appoint my said loving wife Catherine Everett and my  
youngest son Joseph Everett to be my executors to this my last Will  
& Testament, and I disown & make void all former & other wills  
& testaments be me made whether in word or writing & declare this
