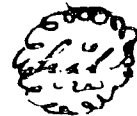


The sales after paying all legal expenses shall be equally divided

In the name of God Amen. I James Findley of Metchenbury
County, being at present sick & weak in body, but of a sound &
disposing mind & memory blessed be God, & calling to mind the mor-
tality of the body & that it is appointed for all men once to die
Do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form
following Viz First Of all I recommend my soul to God who gave it
& my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent
manner at the discretion of my Executors herein after named
& as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless
me in this life I give & dispose of the same as follows.

First I will that my just debts be paid & discharged as soon as
convenient after my decease. In witness I give & bequeath unto
my son William a part of the land I now live on to be laid off to
him in the following manner Viz Beginning on my line where
it crosses the road leading from my house to the house of John
Gordon & runs S 45 East to a Hickory thence N 55 East to the
corner of McWhorters old line crossing the creek to a Hickory McWhorters
corner thence N 45 West 54 poles to a red Oak said McWhorters corner
thence to the corner of my field next to said McWhorters, thence with
the side of said field to a lick by the creek, thence crossing said
creek & up the side of the said creek to the mouth of a small branch
thence up the various meanders of the said branch to the adjoining
road, thence to the beginning; supposed to be about 1/2 mile
be the same more or less and his heirs in fee simple -
Then I will & bequeath to my son in law Thomas White the land

he now live on containing one hundred acres. That some more or less
to him & his heirs forever in full simple - them. I give & bequeath unto
my Daughter Sarah the remainder of the said more live on together
with forty acres adjoining the same to her & her heirs forever in full
simple - And as to my son Charles & my Daughter Martha wife to
Daniel Robersons having given them formerly I make no further
provision for them in this my will; I likewise leave unto my Daughter
Sarah all my Stock of Horses, Cattle & Hogs & plantation tools and
farming utensils, my household & kitchen furniture & all outstanding
debts due to me, & all or any property belonging to me not herein
before mentioned, she paying out of the same the following sum viz
to my sons James, John & George to each of them one dollar if they
come to receive the same within 12 months after my decease, and
to my Daughter wife to William Chapin one Dollar & to my former
son in law Henry Hargett one Dollar. - And lastly I do hereby nomi-
nate my Daughter Sarah the sole executrix of this my last will
& Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me heretofore
made, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my seal this 16th day of January 1806 -
