till the youngest comes of age, what shall then be doing, I desire that  
my wife Jane shall then be sole Executrix of all my Estate, land  
and houses, & I desire & charge Samuel Allen, for his assistance  
over my wife to see the same truly Executed and performed.

of body but of sound mind & memory, calling to mind my last  
written will & Testament, do make & ordain this as my last will  
& Testament, and first I give my soul to God who gave it to  
my body to the Earth, And as touching such worldly estate as  
God hath given me I give & dispose of in the following manner  
viz I will give & bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife Mary  
one half of all my Estate both real & personal & if it appear to my  
executors hereafter reasonable that the said half is not sufficient to  
support my said wife during her the remainder of her longing  
life, that then & in that case I will & bequeath to her the said Mary  
the two thirds of all my said Estate, & rather than my said beloved

case order will & bequeath to her my said wife Mary the three  
fourths of all my said Estate, and the priuilege of laying an  
enjoying the benefit of my land as long as my said Executrix  
judges fit for her & the childrens behavour making them  
thereon with her free of charge -

I will give & bequeath unto my beloved Children Joseph Kline  
William Kline, Andrew Kline, Elizabeth Kline, Rebecca Kline  
& Jane Kline the residue & remainder of all my said estate  
that is, the one half, the one third, & the one fourth according as the case  
may be to be equally divided among them, & in such a manner  
as Justice may be done my wife & the above I will give bequeath.
