& my Trusty friend Valentine Weaver the sole Executors of this

In the name of God Amen. I James Franklin of Newbury
County being weak of body but of sound mind & judgment, make
this my last will & Testament & by these presents do revoke all wills
heretofore by me made either by word or Writing -
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written
It is my will & desire that my wife & Children live all together
that I have by my wife Jane, I desire that all my estate Real
& personal be Divided & one third part of it be given my wife
Jane & the other two parts to be equally divided among my Children
Except my Daughter Mary Franklin to whom I have one English
Shilling I desire the Negroes to be hired out for the use of my Children
till the youngest comes of age. What shall then be doing, I desire that
my wife Jane Franklin be sole Executrix of all my Estate, Real
& personal and I desire & choose Samuel Allen for Guardian
over my wife to see the same truly Executed and performed

of this my last Will & Testament according to the true intent & meaning As Witness my hand & Seal this 28th day of July in the year of our Lord 1764 -

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In the name of God Amen. I Nicholas Thinn being sick & weak of body, but of sound mind & memory, calling to mind my last & approving disposition, Do make & ordain this as my last Will & Testament, and first I give my Soul to God who gave it & my body to the Earth, And as touching such worldly estate as God hath given me I give & dispose of in the following manner
I Will give & bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife Mary one half of all my Estate both real & personal & if it appears to my Executors hereafter named that the said half is not sufficient to support my said living wife thro' the remainder of her lingering life, that then & in that case, I Will & bequeath to her the said Mary the two thirds of all my said Estate, & rather than my said beloved wife Mary should be troubled & become a burden, & the said two thirds not being sufficient to support her, I then in that case order Will & bequeath to her my said wife Mary the three fourths of all my said Estate; and the privilege of living on & enjoying the benefit of my land as long as my said Executors Judge it for her & the Childrens Advantage in keeping them thereon with her free of Charge—

Then I Will give & bequeath unto my beloved Children Joseph Thinn William Thinn, Andrew Thinn, Ebenezer Thinn, Rebecca Thinn & Jane Thinn the residue & remainder of all my said Estate that is the one half, the one third, or the one fourth according as the same may be to be equally divided among them, & in Order that ample Justice may be done my wife & Children I Will give & bequeath
