I likewise constitute & appoint Robert Harris ~~and~~ son to Charles Harris and my two Sons Samuel & James to be my executors of this my last will & Testament. And my two Sons Samuel & John & Charles Harris & son Robert to be guardians for my two daughters Josephine & Mary & my Daughter Josephine son baptist.

" In the Name of God Crown I Joseph Thomas of the County of Mecklenburg & State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind & memory thanks be to God therefore calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make & Ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say Principally & first of all I give my soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to the dust to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my executors & touching such worldly Estate where with it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give & dispose of the same in the following manner & form viz - I give & bequeath unto Sarah Thomas my dearly beloved wife all & singular that part of my estate which became mine at our intermarriage & which she was intitled to by her former Husband the property of which was less than a day before she became my wife.

Item. I give & bequeath to Celia Thomas my beloved son the one half of the Value of all my Lands & Tenements -
