& her heirs & what ever remains John to get it, and William
Nesbitt of South Carolina & Rebecca May of N. Carolina I appoint
Executors & Administrators of this my last will & Testament, & I do dis-
allow & disannul all former wills, And Ratify this as my last will

" Be it known to all whom it may concern, That I James Henry
of the County of Mecklenburg in the State of N. Carolina being in
health & of sound mind & memory, Do make & ordain this my last
will & Testament in manner & form following—
I Will & bequeath to Dorcas Henry in lieu of her dower her bed & furniture
my Dish & hook case, her spinning wheel, Heren Press & all the things one
half of the kitchen & Table furniture, her Saddle & bridle, & four horn
or the young black mare as she may choose & the privilege of living
in my house during her life or widowhood & also all & every part of the
Household furniture not mentioned or bequeathed by this my will at the
disposal of my wife
I Will & bequeath unto my son William Henry the whole of that plan-
tation called Blackwoods, like a piece of land belonging to the planta-
tion on which I now live lying along the North line of said

Blackwood's plantation beginning at a White Oak Corner of the plantation on which I lived & running with the line Northward down the west side of the meadow branch untill it comes opposite to the South East corner of my field joining said branch thence to the fence along the same to the same or East corner thence the course of the same untill it is in the line of said Blackwood plantation be the same more or less, also his man & his two Cattle, one young cow his sow & piggs & one half of the plantation and Carpenter Tools -

I Will & bequeath unto my Daughter Jane Henry her Gray mare saddle & bridle one bed & furniture, her chest of Drawers, three Linen & Colours & one half of the Kitchen & Table furniture -

I Will & bequeath unto my son Thomas Henry his whole of the plantation on which I now live (except what is above mentioned) together with the Twenty acres bought from John Cousin, also the several mare & the boy three year old filly one young cow & a sow & piggs, one half of the plantation & Carpenter Tools -

I Will & bequeath unto my daughter Martha Henry under the name of pin killing

I Will & bequeath unto my son Geo. Henry one several two year old Cattle -

I Will & bequeath unto my son Cyrus Henry my Black horse his saddle & bridle & three hundred dollars in money but in case there should be any failure in raising said sum my sons Thomas & William shall pay at a time agreed upon by my executors the two thirds of the said failure may take place. It is further my Will & pleasure that the residue of my estate not herein bequeathed be sold by my executors & after paying all my last debts & the Legacies herein bequeathed to be equally divided between my wife & all my Children share & share alike -

And lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my son Thomas Henry & Deot Joseph McNeill Alexander & Isaac Alexander the sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby disannulling all former Wills bequeathments or legacies before made. Ratifying & confirming this above as my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the 6th day of May 1806 Signed Sealed Published & declared

I will & bequeath unto my son George Henry one seven two year old Cattle—

I will & bequeath unto my son Cyrus Henry my black horse his saddle & bridle & three hundred dollars in money but in case there should be any failure in raising said sum my sons Thomas & William shall pay at a time agreed upon by my executors the two thirds of the said failure may take place. It is further my will & pleasure that the residue of my estate not herein bequeathed be sold by my executors & after paying all my last debts & the Legacies herein bequeathed to be equally divided between my wife & all my Children share & share alike—
