" Loony in Sebastian, being in distreight & afraid of bodily, but of
" mind & memory thanks to God therefore writing to mind the
" Mortality of my body & approaching oblation. Do make do
" certain this my last will & Testament this principally & first of all
" I give my soul into the hand of Almighty God to agree it
" & thy glory & thy command to the earth to be buried in
" a decent manner at the discretion of my executors not doubt
" ing but I shall receive the same again at the general Resurrection
" by the Almighty power of God. And touching such worldly
" estate as it hath pleased God to bestow me with in this life. I now
" will give & bequeath the same in the following manner & form 173
" Myself James Beane Sebastian unto my well beloved wife Peggy
" & her daughter my dearest girl Maria. Now ravishing seven years of age 1.
" & privilege of living on & enjoying the benefit of the plantation
" on which I now dwell upon as will be necessary for the support
" part of the family during her daies & to further this my
" will & pleasure that my beloved wife & children be in number
" ten thousand together in a family capacity for the term of 15
" years. & that all or so much of my personal estate shall remain
" in the hands of my wife Peggy during said term of fifteen years
" as my executors may judge sufficient to enable her to mind
" also the like number of children 173 Henry, Samey, Peggy L,
" James D, Robert & Billy & the rest of it is further my will do
" pleasure that at the expiration of said term of 15 years or if my
" wife should decease before that time all my personal estate
" except my negro be divided by three men namely my executors
" among the same to mind, and my wife Peggy shall of my children
" to receive an equal share of said property and if there

The Executors & Trustees may claim it more proper to sell said
 Estate & receive their dividends in money, then at said time all
 my Negroes (except the one above bequeathed to my wife) are
 to be hired yearly until my Children are come to the age
 of twenty one & in case my wife should marry or die be-
 fore the arrival of that time it is my request that the land
 be retained till then at which time said Land & negroes are
 to be distributed as in the sum. However as directed in the
 distribution of the personal estate remunerating to others
 that the negro above bequeathed to my wife Piggy is to be
 at that time valued to be as part of her equal share of
 all my Estate which negro at her (Piggy's) death is to be
 disposed of to the equal benefit of all my above named chil-
 dren After It is my will & pleasure that in case any of my above
 named Children should marry during the above mentioned
 sum of sixteen years, that they receive such pecuniary property
 as my heirs after me would receive may judge proper for their
 assistance in taking up house. Said property to be valued
 to them children as slaves & considered in aspect of their safety
After It is my will & pleasure that if all or any of my above
 named Sons should incline to have a trade they are allowed
 the privilege of choosing their own trade & to be bound
 at the age of seventeen to serve for the term of three years
 & then to work journey work for the term of one year & to
 enjoy the benefit of their own wages, & find their own lodgings
 for said year & further it is my desire that there be such a
 deduction made out of the legacy of those who may be entitled
 as may be judged proper by my Executors to remunerate those of
 my above named Children who may at the time of their absence
 be laboring for the benefit of the testator After It is my will & to
 pleasure that all my lawful debts be paid; After It is my will
 & pleasure that if my Executors may consider a sum of prop-
 erty now left is sufficient for the purpose mentioned during
 the above mentioned sixteen years that the money raised out of
 said property is to go to the use of the family if need so require, &
 will be kept by them for the equal use of all my legatees

... I do make & give my wife my children & all who are about the age
of Twenty one & in case my wife should marry or die be-
fore this arrival of that time it is my request that the land
be sold & tell them at what time said land & negroes is
to be disposed of in the sume manner as directed in the
distribution of the personal estate remaning to whom
that the negro slave bequeathed to my wife Peggy is to be
at that time valued to her aspect of her equal divide of
all my estate which negro at her (Peggy's) death is to be
disposed of to the equal benefit of all my slaves mind that
then Item It is my will & pleasure that in case any of my above
named Children should die during the above mentioned
sum of fifteen years that they receive back pieces of property
as my heirs after named Executors may judge proper for their
apparition in taking up house & land property to be valued
in their choice as slaves & consider in aspect of their property
Item It is my will & pleasure that if all or any of my above
named Sons should die & have a brde they are allowed
the proceeds of selling their own brde & take bound
at the age of seventeen to serve for the term of three years
& then to work during work for the term of one year & to
enjoy the benefit of their own wages & find their own clothing
for said year & further it is my desire that there be such a
dedication made out of the legacy of those who may transact
as may be judged proper by my Executors to encompass those of
my above named Children who may at the time of their absence
be laboring for the benefit of the estate Item It is my will & pleasure
that all my lawful debts be paid; Item It is my will & pleasure
that if my Executors may consider a sumptuous prop-
erty over what is sufficient for the purpose mentioned during
the above mentioned fifteen years that the money raised out of
said property is to go to the use of the family if need so requires &
not to be paid to them for the equal use of all my legatees
And I do constitute & appoint my trusty friends the under-
Named, Thomas A. Wilson & my dear & beloved wife Margaret
& Martin & John West to be my sole executors of this my last
Will & Testament & in case any of them should be removed

by death or otherwise the survivors have liberty to constitute
 & appoint others to supply the Vacancy, & to declare thereby
 whoe & whom all my other friends, Will, Testaments
 legacies or Executors by me in any wise named & called or
 appointed before, Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be
 my last will & Testament. In witness whereof the said James
 Martin have caused to set my hand & affixed my seal this 22^d
 day of March in the year of our Lord 1810.

 imperfect mind & memory. Do constate & make this my last
 will & Testament, and first of all I do wish my body to be
 buried out of my estate 3rd I do think that all my just debts
 shall be paid by my executors 4th I do will to my dearly Bel
 loved wife Sarah Morrison her living off this plantation dur
 ing her widowhood, likewise the Chest of drawers & two beds
 well furnished with clothes & a stand of furniture, likewise
 my two horses & two cows. 5th I do will to my son William
 Morrison the plantation where he first settled 5th I do will
 to my son James Morrison the three hundred dollars that he
 received from me to pay the plantation he now lives on. 6th I do
 will to my sons John & Robert Morrison the plantation I
 purchased from James Morrison to be equally divided
 between them 7th I do will to my son Thomas Morrison
 the plantation on which I now live & likewise the say man
 yplant & the two cows & calves which I left him with their
 increase & likewise all the hogs. 8th I will that the land on the
 plantation Waters shall be divided in the following manner
