

In the name of God Amen, I James McLeod of the County of New Brunswick being very sick but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God, & calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed unto all men Once to die, Do make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament that it today principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it, & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the direction of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, And as Touching such worldly estate I have with it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give & dispose of the same in the following manner & form

First, I give to my well beloved wife the full Third part my personal Estate & to have the benefit of the said during her natural life, I likewise I give to my wife the Choice of all my Horses with harnesses and bridle with all my household furniture, I likewise I give to my daughter Jane fifty pound hard money and I leave her half of my personal Estate. Then I give to my son William the remainder of my personal Estate with all my land at my wife's death & likewise constitute make & Ordain my wife whole & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament. And I do hereby utterly disallow & disannul all & every other former Testament, wills, Legacies, bequests & Resolutions by me in any wise before named written & signed & attested & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 5th day of November 1781.
