them a horse & saddle when of age. 2nd I will that in plantations
or sugar houses etc in Ephrath in case that my executors may give
a right according to our agreement. 3rd I will & desire that the
remainder of my personal estate be left in the hands of my beloved wife
Jane McDowell while she remains my widow to be disposed of by
my children when of age as the executors shall think most to the
advantage of my children. And Lastly I do thorowly & voluntarily
beleave my wife Jane McDowell & her two Sons John & Samuel McDowell
in execution of this my last will & testament. God hereby witness
of my signature & seal & agreement abiding every where this instrument wills
bequeath, legacies & presents & beffying & confirming this one shall be
my last will & testament. In witness whereof she has signed & set my
name & seal the day & year above written -

In the name of god almighty I now make & declare under oath with a clear
& knowing mind & state of health & memory as present & without any bodily
but of a sound & disposing mind & understanding helped by just & feeling
I mind the mortality of the body, I that it is appointed for all men once
to die. To make & renew this my last will & testament in memory of me
I now sign my self of all & command my soul to God who gave it & my
body to the earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the
discretion of my executors hereof mentioned, & as touching such worldly
estate as it has pleased God to bestow me in this life, I give & dispose of the same
in the following manner First of all I will that my first debts & funeral
expenses be paid & discharged as soon as convenient after my death.

Secondly I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Hannah the mother
of my family with the other of my house & other out buildings & rents to
belonging during a natural life & then with my living son &
daughter two horses & colts one feather bed & bedding for one person also
& the rest of the furniture belonging to my house & so much land as
I shall then have left in this life in respect of my debts as well

be meant for the family for two years after my death & food for as many
of the plantation tools, as shall be necessary all the time that it is to be
preserved during her widowhood for the training up of the children and
the maintenance of my children, and if it so happens that my wife doth not
live then my will that my sons be bound to trades such as they shall be
best to be at the direction of my executors & trustees of these last.
The second article left for the schooling & Maintenance of my chd's
that is then in being to be equally to portionable sale of the money arising
from such sale to be equally divided amongst my children & the
survivors of them share & have alike. Item This however my will that
all the remainder of my personal property not here before mentioned
be exposed to publick sale as soon as convenient after my decease &
the money arising from such sale together with my outstanding debt
to be equally divided amongst my children or the survivors of them
as before mentioned. Item This further my will that after the decease of
my wife my plantation that I now live on containing 125 acres, be
exposed to publick sale to the highest bidder & I do hereby command
any one of my executors or any one of my sons let me in their
one year of age to make a sufficient & full & clear conveyance for
same as if I myself were personally present & the money arising from
such sale to be equally divided amongst all my children or the
survivors of them share & have alike as before mentioned, and it is my
will that the money arising from the before mentioned sales with the
interest due thereon if any be paid to each of my sons as they come
at the age of twenty one years of age, & to my daughter at the age of
eighteen or the day of her marriage. Item This further my will that
my well beloved wife Hannah & my friend William Hume & John
son to James Ege Dineard be the sole executors of this my last &
testament. Hereby abdicating & making void all other testaments
by me heretofore made, & signing & confirming this to be my last &
testament. In witness whereof she was hereunto setting her hand &
signed my seal this 23rd day of Oct: in the year of our Lord 1795.

John Hume & his wife acknowledged to be the last will &
testament of the above named James Hume who
at his request has substituted the names of his wife

I therefore desire my Indentured Servants to be my Executors & Trustees and
Maintenance of my Children, and if it do happen that my wife doth die,
it is then my will that my Sons be bound to trades such as they shall be
best fitted to be at the direction of my Executors & Trustees of these last.
The sume of £1000 I give for the schooling & Maintenance of my Children
that is then in being to be equally apportioned to the Money arising
from such sale to be equally divided amongst my Children & the
survivors of them share & have alike. Item It is likewise my Will that
all the remainder of my personal property not here before mentioned
be exposed to publick sale as soon as convenient after my decease &
the money arising from such sale together with my outstanding debt
to be equally divided amongst my children or the survivors of them
as before mentioned. Item It is further my will that after the decease
of my wife my plantation that I now live on containing 125 acres, be
exposed to publick sale to the highest bidder & I do hereby restrain
any one of my Executors or any one of my Sons to let me have
one year of age to make a sufficient & full account of the same, for
so much if myself were personally present & the money arising from
such sale to be equally divided amongst all my Children or the
survivors of them share & have alike as before mentioned, and it is my
will that the money arising from the before mentioned sales with the
Interest due thereupon if any be paid to each of my Sons as they are
at the age of twenty one years of age, & to my Daughter at the age of
eighteen on the day of her marriage. Item It is further my will that
my late beloved wife Hannah & my friend William Horne & my
Son to James Bigg be the sole Executrix of this my last
Testament. Having read, considered, & confirmed this to be my last
Testament. In witness whereof she has caused to set my hand
against myself this 23rd day of October in the year of our Lord 1795
Signed, sealed & delivered & acknowledged to be the last will &
Testament of the above named James, & his wife
at his request having substituted my name at his desire.
