named during her life to supply her in her necessity as my Executors
as a way of of them may think right & best. She living at all times
under the direction & subject to the Council & Guardianship of my Executors
as long as she remains my widow at her decease the said two thirds or
what Balance may be on hand, I will & bequeath to my niece Mary Boyds
& should my Executors find my personal Estate insufficient to support
my widow then they are to have recourse to my real Estate as far as
they may deem necessary. As to my Real Estate I will & bequeath
that tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County of Lincoln
on Long Creek containing one hundred & fifty four acres to my nephew
Thomas Boyds to his only use & behoof forever after the decease of my
widow. As to the Tract of Land lying in the Township of which I purchased
from John Githupie I will & bequeath it to my Executors power to
dispose of it by sale to the best advantage or opportunity they may have
the amount or price of said Tract of Land lying on Compacreek South
Carolina, I will & bequeath to the above named Mary Boyds & should
she die before the decease of my Widow then & in that case to be divided
among said Mary Boyds brothers & her as equally then & there.
Lastly I do hereby constitute my Trusty & true beloved friends Thomas Green
James Porter & Hugh Harnon to be the Executors of this my last will &
Testament. I declare this to be my last will & Testament in presence of us
