acting or the remaining my widow at her decease the said two thirds or
what Ballance may be on hand. I will & bequeath my house at Boylston
I named my Executors find my personal estate insufficient to support
my widow then they are to have recourse to my real estate as far as
they may deem necessary. As to my Real estate I will & bequeath
that tract of land lying & being in the County of Franklin
in Long Creek containing one hundred & fifty four acres to my nephew
Thomas Boylston to his only son & his heirs forever after the decease of my
widow as to the tract of land lying in the Woods over which bounded
from John Gill, spc I will & bequeath it to my Executors power to
divide it by sale to the best advantage or opportunity they may have
the amount or price of said tract of Land lying on Camp Creek said to be
Carolina. I will & bequeath to the above named Harry Boylston & himself
the other before the decease of my widow then & so that he is to be divided
among said Harry Boylston brothers & self as equally there shall
firstly I do hereby constitute my trusty & beloved friend Thomas Gray
James Parker & Hugh Horner to be the Executors of the my last will &
testament & declare this to be my last will & Testament in presence of us
