 also that John Harris shall have the said negro boy George 1/2
 dollars under his apprenticeship. I will & bequeath to

 and Lastly, I do hereby constitute & appoint James Nelson
 & John Harris my lawful Executors of this my last will &
 Testament, hereby desiring & commanding all other

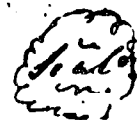

& memory thanks be given to Almighty God, calling to mind the
mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die, Do hereby & therein this my last will & Testament, that I do by
this & principally, I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty
God that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my
executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the Almighty power of God.
And as touching such worldly Estate, whereunto it has pleased God
to bestow upon me in this life, I give, Devise & bequeath of the same
in the following manner & form. First I Will that all my just debts
be paid together with all my funeral charges. Next I bequeath unto
my loving son Abraham Miller my plantation whereon I now live
containing two hundred acres of Land. Item I leave unto my wife
Ann Miller my black boy man & one cow & calf, one bed and
bedding, one chest & such of the household furniture as she thinks
proper to keep together with her living on the land during her Na-
tural life. Item I leave unto Sarah Wallace one cow. Item I leave
five silver dollars to support the Gospel in Deepwell Church.
Item I Will that my body have burial of Land with the balance
of the State of Carolina & such of the household furniture, as my
wife does not think proper to keep is to be sold & the money arising
therefrom with my notes, & such debts to be appropriated to her
use during her Natural life, and after her decease, if anything
should remain to be equally divided among my Children.
I will my wife & constitute & make with her assistance
