Item I will & bequeath to my brother John Miller one dollar
Item I will & bequeath to Eleanor Nelson one hundred dollars
Item I will & bequeath to John Nelson forty Dollars -
Item I will & bequeath to Eleanor one hundred sixty dollars, and my
bed & household furniture; Item I will & bequeath to my
Sally dollars; Item I will & bequeath to John
Item I will & bequeath to John one hundred fifty dollars
that my Executors shall be equally divided between Eleanor & John
Nelson & John one hundred from children; Item I will & bequeath to
Montgomery my saddle & bridle. Item I will & bequeath to James
my wearing clothes & his wife & her maid my shawl
Item My will is that my negro boy George shall not be sold but
that he will be provided by James Nelson; & Robert one hundred
dollars that John & Harris shall have the said negro boy George - Item
Martha & Morrison ten dollars Item I will & bequeath to
my wife to Eleanor Nelson, John Nelson, Eleanor one hundred
& John & Harris hereby constitute & appoint James Nelson
Testaments hereby mentioning & designating all other

and Testaments heretofore made by me formerly & confirm this to

& Memory Thanks be given to Almighty God, calling into mind the
Mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die, Do make & Publish this my last Will & Testament, That into my
Joint & principally, I recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty
God that give it & my body I recommend to the Earth to be
Buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my
Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the Almighty power of God.
And as touching such worldly Estate, whereunto it has pleased God
to bestow upon me in this life, I give Devise & Dispose of the same
in the following manner & form - First I Will that all my just debts
be paid together with all my funeral charges. Next I give & bequeath unto
my loving son Abraham Miller my plantation whereon I now live
containing two hundred acres of Land, Item I leave unto my wife
Ann Miller my slave boy man & one cow & calf, one bed and
bedding, one Chest & such of the household furniture as she thinks
proper to keep together with her living on the land during her Na-
tural life. Item I leave unto Sarah Wallace one Cow. Item I leave
five silver dollars to support the Gospel in Deepwell Church
Item I Will that my body be laid with the ballance
of the State of Carolina & such of the household furniture, as my
wife does not think proper to keep is to be sold & the money arising
therefrom with my notes & other debts to be appropriated to her
use during her Natural life, and after her decease, if anything
should remain to be equally divided among my Children
I will that my Will & constitute & make with the assistance
