 & disposing mind & memory beseech the God & Father to mind the mortaling
 of the body & that it is appointed for all men briefly to die, do make the
 record in this my last will & Testament in the manner & form following
 viz. Principally & first of all I recommend my soul to God who
 gave it, and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian
 like & decent manner at the discretion of my executors herein after
 named; and as touching my worldly estate as it hath pleased God
 to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same as follows
 First I will that my just debts & funeral expenses be paid and
 discharged as soon as convenient after my death
 Impri. I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth the planter
 ion whereon I now live with all the improvements to the same be
 longing during her widowhood without any interference, excepting
 raising & educating my three children in a gentle & decent man
 ner. & in place of Marriage the title to continue in possession of one
 third of said plantation including the improvements, during her
 natural life. Likewise will & bequeath to my said wife three negra
 men, Hilly & Past to be entirely at her own disposal together with
 my young son & his horse & saddle & bridle three plows & gears for the
 horses, likewise, one cow & other labor to be chosen by her out of my
 stock, in a year or two to be at her own choice, in head of hogs thought
 by my executors most suitable for her, four head of sheep, also two
 beds, & furniture one chest of drawers, my Stage & Road waggon &
 pot, two bows, Tea kettle & Table person & house suitable for the same
 the above mentioned property to be at the entire disposal of my said
 wife. It is my desire that these work horses be left for the use of my young
 & children on the plantation during her widowhood. & in case of
 marriage to be disposed of for the use of my children —

2d. I will & bequeath unto my son John Houston the plantation
 I now live on at the death of my wife & two tracts of land of James
 Mathews on Little Spring creek one tract I purchased at my fathers sale
 adjoining land of Benjamin Fincher & the Springs & one tract I purchased
 of Mr. Fincher adjoining said lands to him his heirs & assigns for me &
 all profits arising from the above mentioned lands to take care

of this body & Will, appointed for all men to do what he
pleaseth in this my last will & Testament in the manner & form following
viz. Principally & first of all I recommend my soul to God who
gave it, and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian
like & decent manner at the disposition of my executors herein after
named; and as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God
to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same as follows
First I will that my just debts & funeral expenses be paid and

Horses, likewise, four cows & other talents to be chosen by her out of my
stock, her choice to be at her own choice, for want of hogs thought
by my executors most suitable for her, four head of sheep, also two
hens & poults, one chest of Drapery, my Stage & Road waggon, two
pots, two bowls, Tea kettle & Table furniture suitable for the same
the above mentioned property to be at the entire disposal of my said
wife. It is my desire that these be left for the use of my young
& children on the plantation during her widowhood. & in case of
marriage to be disposed of for the use of my children —
I will & bequeath unto my son John Houston the plantation
I now live on at the death of my wife & two tracts, hundred of land
Matthews on St. Johns creek one tract 1/2 ac. shared at my fathers sale
adjoining land of Benjamin Fincher & the springs there tract I mean
it, let his heirs adjoining said lands to him his heirs & his wife for ever &
all profits arising from the above mentioned lands to take up
at Twenty one years. I likewise will & bequeath to my daughter
four negroes named George, April, Anna & Eleanor
in I will & bequeath to my Daughter Margaret that plantation

 of marriage with all profits arising from the same to her & her
 Heirs forever I also bequeath my said daughter from me now to
 Hannah, wife, Eliza & Rebekah to her & her heirs for ever -
 Item I Will & bequeath to my son Robert Boyd the plantation house
 from James Banks with the profits arising from the same by
 he enjoys at the age of twenty one years to him this Heirs forever
 Likewise bequeath my said son four negroes named Jim, Joseph,
 Henry to him & his Heirs forever and if long of them my three children
 should die before they come of age their share of property to be equally
 divided between the other two there & there alike -
 Item I Will & bequeath to my sister by law Esther Walker one horse
 to be valued to Sixty Dollars & one half to be delivered
 her by my executors - It is my will that what bill of sale
 provided be used for the horse I have built, it is likewise my will
 all my property, not herein before mentioned be exposed to public
 sale by my executors as soon as convenient after my decease the
 money arising from such sale together with all outstanding debts
 be divided as follows viz To my wife Elizabeth one hundred Dollars
 to my Sister viz Agnes, Margaret Patterson & Susannah
 I Will & bequeath the sum of Fifty dollars each is to be paid as
 convenient by my executors, It is also my desire that a sum
 of provision be laid off for my widow & family for one year by my
 executors, And Lastly that all the remainder of monies arising
 from sale of property be divided amongst my three children as
 here & there alike - And Lastly I do hereby nominate Hopper
 & constitute my wife Elizabeth my brotherly law John Patterson
 William Newell to be the sole executors of this my last will &
 Testament, hereby revoking & making void all former wills &
 testaments made, & leaving & comprising this to be my last
 will & testament - In witness whereof these hands set
 hand & signed my seal this 8th day of April anno 1811 -
