I hereby constate & appoint my friend James Evans James Deane to be my executors of this my last will & Testament, having first reciting all other wills, gifts by me made whether by word or writing, Ratifying this & no other to be my last will & Testament, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 3<sup>d</sup> day of April A.D. 1810.
