 be done after my decease; And I do nominate & appoint

 Executor of this my last will & Testament, & I do
 declare this only to be my last will & Testament &
 hereby revoking all others by me heretofore made
 in Writing whereof I the said George Lower the testator
 have heretofore set my hand & seal this first day of
 June in the 4th year of our Lord 1725.

 but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God, therefore
 calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to
 die make & declare this my last will & Testament, that
 is to say principally & first of all I give my soul into
 the hands of Almighty God who gave it, And my body
 I recommend to the dust to be buried in a Christian man-
 ner & in a decent like manner at the direction of my Executors
 herein after mentioned And as touching such worldly
 Estate as it has been pleasing to God to bestow upon me with

in this life I give & dispose of the same, in the following
manner & form viz. First I give & bequeath to my beloved
son David Sawyer three hundred & fifty acres of land in or near
Duck river in Green County being part of a tract of land
I bought from Amos Black to him his heirs & assigns forever
& also my large bible & three shawl buckles & my brown blanket
2^{dly} I give & bequeath unto my beloved son Benjamin Sawyer
three hundred & twenty five acres of land part of the above
mentioned tract of land to him his heirs & assigns forever &
also my silver three buckles & three buttons & my other clothes
3^{dly} I give & bequeath to my beloved son James Sawyer three
hundred & twenty five acres of land being the remainder of
the above said tract of land purchased of Amos Black to him
his heirs & assigns forever the whole of said tract contain-
ing one thousand acres which is to be divided as nearly in
equality as can be & each to have his quantity as afore-
mentioned & also my silver shawl buckles & my three buttons
marked 15 & the pocket bible in which his name is written
and my chest. 4^{thly} I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter
the elderly Sawyer all my first wifes apparel & my pocket bible
in which her name is written & also one plow & saddle & bridle & three
matras shawl buckles together with the sum of one hundred &
fifty pounds lawful money of S^c Carolina to be paid out of
my personal estate together with the interest thereof.
5^{thly} I give & bequeath unto my said three sons the plan-
tation whereon I have lived on to be divided as nearly
as possible in value each having equal share of the
several benefits of said water meadows land & timber as
can conveniently be in his part without hurt to the other
viz to David one hundred & to Benjamin one hundred & to
James one hundred & the remaining one hundred and
sixty eight acres to be divided by man appointed & under
the inspection of my Executors to make each sons share
as near of value as may be, each to enjoy his part of eye
or Marriage the said lands to be divided by lot
in first & second choice the eldest having the first choice
& so in course. 6^{thly} It is my will & desire that the above

Said land be rent out to some careful husband for
 for the use & benefit of the said Legatee & discharge of
 the publick charge on the same until the said Legatee
 is Intall'd to have possession & he is answerable for the same
 y^{thly} I will & allow that all my personal estate be sold
 such as is not already be, wth that all my just debts
 & funeral charges be punctually paid out of the same & the
 books not already given to be equally divided amongst
 the aforesaid Legatee as near in value as may be by my
 direction & that all & every of the remainings part of my
 personal estate be divided as follows Viz To my sons three
 parts of my estate either real or personal I will & give to
 each Legatee an equal share - 8^{thly} & Lastly, I do hereby
 nominate constitute & appoint my trusty & well beloved
 friend, John Garrison & John Beatty to be my executors of
 this my last will & Testament, and do hereby utterly
 disallow revoke & disannul, and every other former
 wills, Testaments & Executors by me made willed or
 appointed heretofore Ratifying & confirming this & no
 other to be my last will & Testament. In witness whereof

 & seal this 28th day of August in the Year of our Lord 1787
