In the name of God Amen. I James Sloan of Mecklenburg
County & State of North Carolina being sick & weak in body
but of perfect mind & memory thank's be to God for it,
and calling to mind that it is appointed for all men
once to die. Do make this my last Will & Testament
as follows expressions first of all I order all my just
debts to be paid - 2nd I give & bequeath to my beloved
wife Jane her choice of one of all my horse creatures &
my saddle horses where & all my household furniture
3rd I give & bequeath unto my son Joseph the plantation
that I now live on to him & his heirs forever, et cetera
the marriage or the death of my wife b'th I give the
bequeath unto my daughters Mary & Rachel each
of them a box - 5th The remainder of my property to
be divided by three trustees chosen by my executors
if the said property is valued, then my executors to
give of the said property to each of my children to the
amount of two pounds except my son Joseph, what remain
of the plantation I leave at the disposal of my beloved wife
Lastly I do ordain & appoint my beloved wife Jane
& my son John Sloan to be the executors of this
last Will & Testament & to see that it be according to the
true intent & meaning thereof, and I do hereby revoke
this document all other former wills & testaments heretofore
by me made & do publish this & no other to be my
last Will & Testament this 13th day of July 1792
