I James Stafford being in health & perfect mind & memory calling to mind the Mortality of my body & that it is appointed for all men one to die, I do constitute this my last will & testament, and first of all I commend my spirit into the hand of God that gave it & my body to be buried in a Christian & decent manner at the discretion of my heirs & executors & as touching my worldly estate wherewithal it hath pleased God to bless me I dispose of in the following manner townt I give and bequeath unto my son James that tract of land he now lives upon purchased by me from Morris Moor & likewise fifty acres lying on the west side of Dobb's line, I also bequeath to my daughter Jane a negro girl named Kate —

I also will & bequeath to my son George all my real and personal estate he paying my servant Betty — I also constitute & appoint my Sons James Stafford & George Stafford my executors to this my last will & testament signed sealed & delivered this 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 1803
