In the name of God Amen, I James Walker of the County of
 Mecklenburg & State of N: Carolina, Farmer being very sick
 & weakly & in perfect health of body but on & of perfect
 mind & memory thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind
 the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for
 all men once to die; Do make & declare this my last
 will & Testament, that in to say principally & first of all
 I give & recommend my soul to the hand of Almighty God
 that gave it, And my body I recommend to the Earth
 to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the dis-
 cretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at
 the general resurrection I shall receive that same again
 by the mighty power of God; And as touching such world-
 ly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless in this
 life I give & dispose of the same in the fol-
 lowing manner & form. First I give & bequeath to
 Margaret my dearly & well beloved wife &
 off the said plantation where she now lives
 her lifetime & the thirds of the same at my death
 & one white mare & three cows & three said hogs that she
 now lives in — Also I give to my wife her and son
 Matthew the sum of thirty pounds in money & also
 I give & bequeath to my sons James & Robert this

said plantation whereon I now live at my decease
 I give & bequeath to daughter Elizabeth the sum of
 Twenty pounds when leaving off the plantation while
 she lives singly & to my daughter & mother the sum of
 five shillings Sterling. My Executors is well known & let
 William Robt & Margaret Holden, bond & also hereby
 utter by disallows, Rescues & disannul all & every
 other former Testaments, wills, legacies, bequests &
 Executors by me in any wise before named written
 & by us attes, Notifying & confirming this & no other
 is in my last will & Testament. In Witnes whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 5th day of
 July 1735 - Signed, Sealed, published
 pronounced & declared by the said James Walker
 as his last will & Testament in the presence
 of us who in the presence of each other
 have hereunto subscribed our names -
