my young man called fly to be his, 3<sup>rd</sup> and lastly I do  
give point left after John A. Lee & Alexander Wallace to execute  
my last will & Testament, and I do nowhere, disown  
and renounce all former wills whatever made by  
me before to destroy but will the testament to be witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1807  
in presence of James Haynes John A. Lee James Beatty

In the name of God, I James Haynes having myself etc  
I know that I must depart before long. This in a good  
state of health it presented doth bear this my last will &  
testament that is to say my will is that the half of my  
estate be put out at interest & that my wife Catherine  
receive the income yearly & every year for her support  
during her natural life that her death to descend as  
hereafter directed & give & bequeath to my wife son  
James Griffith all the rest of my estate to him his heirs  
legitimes forever. Also that part I left to his mother to  
take at her death. Lastly I do ordain constitute  
& appoint my wife son James Griffith which shall  
be witness of this my last will & Testament, as witness  
they here & seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of January in the year of  
our Lord 1807.
