In the name of God Amen, I James Wilson of the State of North
Carolina & County of Rockingham, being of sound mind
& memory, do make & declare this my last will & testament
in manner & form following that is to say First I will
that all my debts be paid by Executors hereinafter
named. Then I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Wilson
his heirs & assigns forever that part of my plantation where
on he now lives beginning at a heap of stones the corner
between me & Matthews Sr & George's land running
thence N. 23 E 308 poles to a stake 16 poles to the left of
a Hickory my corner, & thence S. 45 E 1/2 corner was on Day
to the dotted line in procession plot 10 acres. I also
forgive him all the debts he owes me by note of hand
book account or otherwise Then I give & bequeath
to my son John Wilson his heirs forever all that
plantation or tract of land whereon I now live
Exclusive of that part I have willed to my son Thomas
together with all my Negroes & all & every other
property that I possess either real or personal with this
Proviso that within Twelve months after my decease
he shall pay to my daughter Sarah Miller the sum
of Ten dollars & to my daughter Elizabeth the
sum of Ten dollars & to my son James Ten dollars
& to my daughter Martha Hedley the sum of
Thirty dollars & to Margaret Fourteen dollars & half
and my will & pleasure is that if my son John

Wilson dies without a lawful begotten issue my three
 Negroes Charlotte, Julia & Maria shall be sold at public
 sale among the other Legates to wit Thomas Jane Elizabeth
 James & Martha & none to bid but the Legates & the
 money arising from that sale to be equally divided
 between my two sons & three daughters viz Thomas
 James, Jane, Elizabeth & Martha. Lastly I do make
 & constitute my son John Wilson my sole Executor
 of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof
 I hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this 15th day
 of June in the Year of our Lord 1815

In the Name of God Amen. I Thomas Heir of the
 County of Middlebury & State of N^o Carolina, being
 in a weakly state of health but of sound mind &
 memory Thanks be to God Therefor, calling to
 mind the mortality of my body knowing that it is
 appointed for all men once to die, Do make & ordain
 this my last Will & Testament, That it is to say principally
 & first of all I give my soul into the hand of Almighty
 God That gave it, and my body I recommend to the dust
 to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion
 of my Executors. and as touching such worldly estate
 wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in
 this life I give & dispose of the same in the following
 manner & form viz I give & bequeath unto Margaret
 Heir my dearly beloved wife all that plantation
 on which I now live for & during her life I also give
 her one old black mare, I also give her one red & white
 Cow & calf & one spotted sow & six pigs, I also
