In the Name of God Amen. I James Wilson of the State of North Carolina & County of Rockingham, being of sound mind & memory, do make & retain this my last will & testament in manner & form following that is to say First I will that all my debts be paid by Executors herein after named. Then I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Wilson his Heirs & his forever that part of my plantation whereon he now lives, beginning at a hump of stones the corner between the Yards between Mr. George Land O'Leary's there N. 23 E 303 poles to a tree 16 poles to the left of a Hickory my corner, & from this place run a Dug to the dotted line in proportion plot 10 acres, I also forgive him all the debts he owes me by note of hand back account or otherwise Then I give & bequeath to my son John Wilson his Heirs forever all that plantation or tract of land whereon I now live exclusive of that part I have willed to my son Thomas together with all my Negroes & all property other property that I possess either real or personal with this proviso that within twelve months after my death he shall pay to my daughter Jane Miller the sum of Ten dollars & to my daughter Elizabeth being the sum of Ten dollars & to my son James Ten dollars & to my daughter Martha Hadley the sum of Thirty dollars & to Margaret Flores one hundred dollars and my will & pleasure is that of my son John

Wilson dies without a lawfull begotten Heirs my three
 Negroes Charlotte, Julius & Anna shall be sold at publick
 sale among the other Legacies to wit Thomas Jane Elizabeth
 James & Martha & none to bid but the legatees & the
 money arising from that sale to be equally divided
 between my two sons & three daughters Viz Thomas
 James, Jane, Elizabeth & Martha—Lastly I do make
 & constitute my son John Wilson my sole Executor
 of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof
 I have set my hand & affixed my seal this 15th day
 of June in the year of our Lord 1815

 & first of all I give my soul into the hand of Almighty
 God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the dust
 to be Buried in a decent manner at the discretion
 of my Executors, and as touching such worldly estate
 wherewithal it hath pleased God to bless me with in
 this life I give & dispose of the same in the following
 manner & form Viz I give & bequeath unto Margaret
Wain my dearly beloved wife all that plantation
 on which I now live for & during her life I also give
 her one old black mare, I also give her one red & white
 cow & calf & one brother sow & six pigs, I also
