 tion to whom I commit the care of Education of the  
 said Mary & Elizabeth; Item I give & bequeath to  
Mary Alexander my Wifes Eldest daughter two cows  
Item I give & bequeath unto Alice Alexander my wifes second  
 daughter two cows It is further my will & pleasure  
 that all the wool & flax now in my possession be left  
 undyed for the use of the family; further it is my will  
 that all the remainder of my personal estate be sold  
 by my Executors & the Money arising from that sale  
 after my just debts & these legacies herein before  
 mentioned be paid, be equally divided among all  
 the rest of my children to wit, John M'Henry Wilson,  
James Wilson, Deborah Wilson & Anna Wilson Item I  
 desire give & bequeath unto each & every one of my  
 children Mary Alexander & Alice Alexander one good  
 peckit Bible to be purchased by my Executors at their  
 discretion Item I desire give & bequeath unto

Isaac Alexander, William Alexander son to Henry Alexander  
John Parks Junr & Joseph Gable on finding each all that

 held apprenticeship thereto belonging from & after the

 & fifteen bushels of barley be left unsold for the next  
 winter provision — And I hereby constitute & appoint

 McDowell to be my sole Executrix of this my last will  
 & Testamant & do hereby utterly disallow & revoke  
 disannul all & every other former will, Testaments  
 Legacies & Executrices by me in any wise made, written,

 other to be my last will & Testament, In witness
