 the sum of fifty dollars to be equally

Hood & John Hood my grand sons  
 Then I allow my grand daughter Ellen Brown  
 to be paid out of my Estate the sum of  
 twenty five dollars as a debt due to her  
 Then I give to the said Ellen Brown &  
 daughter of my daughter Mary the sum  
 of fifty dollars more out of my Estate —  
 Then I give to my daughter Eliza and three  
 daughters the sum of fifty dollars to be paid  
 to her or her heirs out of my Estate —  
 Then I give to my son Elias the sum of  
 fifty dollars in like manner. &c. —  
 Then I give unto my daughter James my  
 fourth daughter the sum of thirty dollars  
 & no more as she has caused me a burden  
 of trouble &c. Then I give unto my grand son  
Henry S. Young the sum of three dollars  
 & no more. Then I give unto my son Sam  
Young the sum of fifty dollars &c.  
 Then I give to my daughter William the

Sum of fifty dollars &c. Then I give to my  
son Robert H Young the sum of one hundred  
& thirty dollars. Then I give to my daughter  
Peggy Lucinda the sum of one hundred &  
thirty dollars with one good bed & good furni-  
ture inside - then I give to my daughter  
Hannah Caroline the sum of one hundred  
& fifty dollars with one good bed & good  
furniture inside - and after all is paid is  
paid to the balance of my estate I give  
unto the five youngest ones James George  
Abby Ann Robert Young Peggy Lucinda  
Hannah Caroline her hundred dollars to  
be equally divided between the above  
named five youngest here and there if  
there should be any balance after that  
for it to be equally divided between every  
one of my heirs - Being of sound  
mind & memory & this my last will & testament  
and I desire the honorable Court of Probate  
to receive it as such - and let the carrying  
the same into execution I do appoint my  
friend Wilson Parks as my true & lawful  
executor and I desire that friend Wilson Parks  
to be guardian for my youngest daughter
