

In the name of God amen. I John Eacock of this County of Mecklenburg & State of North Carolina planters litleth week in Worthy yet blessed be God of our mind & memory. Do this 16th day of March in the year of our Lord 1829 make & publish this my last will & Testament & desire the same may be received by all concerned as such as follows in the first place

1st I Will & order that my funeral expences & all my last debts be paid in some convenient time after my decease -

2^d To my beloved wife Barbara Eacock I will & bequeath the two feather beds & furniture and a responsible maintenance to be paid my dwelling house on my plantation during her widowhood or lifetime as may first occur

3^d I Will & bequeath to my son John Eacock a good feather bed & furniture & a good table & chairs or similar articles -

4th I Will & bequeath to my son John Eacock my negro boy Nelson and my children

5th I Will & bequeath to my daughter Betty Eacock one good feather bed and furniture -

6th I Will & bequeath to my daughter Peggy Eacock one good feather bed and furniture

7th I do hereby will & expressy intend that all my household and kitchen furniture not disposed of above as well as my stock of every kind & all my farming implements be retained and kept on this my plantation for the support & accommodation of my widow & the family as usual with us. that at the marriage or death of my said widow or her a care be taken I do hereby will & order that such & such property that is now left & reduced for the support of my family and may then remain, be sold for the best price that may be had, and equally divided among all my children; and my plantation on which land is standing upwards of one hundred negroes may be sold at the same time & equally divided as aforesaid I mean the price thereof - And lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my son John Eacock executor of my last will & testament

received by all concerned as such as follows in the first place
 1st I will & order that my funeral expenses & all my just debts
 be paid in some convenient time after my decease —
 2^d To my beloved wife Barbara Caroch I will & bequeath two feather
 beds & furniture and a comfortable maintenance in order that my beloved
 hand on my plantation during her widowhood & lifetime as
 may first occur
 3^d I will & bequeath to my son Jesse Caroch a good feather bed &
 furniture & a good table & chair or two or three of them —
 4th I will & bequeath to my son Peter Caroch my negro boy Nelson
 and my children
 5th I will & bequeath to my daughter Betty Caroch one good
 feather bed and furniture —
 6th I will & bequeath to my daughter Peggy Caroch one
 good feather bed and furniture
 7th I do hereby will & express by these words that all my household and
 kitchen furniture not disposed of above as well as my stock of
 every kind & all my farming implements be retained and kept
 on this my plantation for the support & accommodation of my
 widow & the family according as that at the marriage or death of
 my said widow Barbara Caroch, I do hereby will, order & direct that
 such & such property that is now left & bequeath for the support
 of my family and may then remain, be sold for the best price that
 may be had, and equally divided among all my children; and my
 plantation on which I am now residing together with my household
 furniture be sold at the same time & equally divided as aforesaid
 I mean the price thereof — And lastly I do hereby nominate &
 appoint my son Thomas Caroch & my friend James Poston
 of this my best will & testament, retaining all others be holding
 in hereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day &
 year above written — In presence of us who were present & saw
 the said Jesse Caroch the Testator sign, seal & execute the same &
 contain his last will & testament & also saw such other signs &
 instruments as he deemed requisite
