29 In the name of God Amen I John Walsh of Mecklenburg
County & State of North Carolina being weak of body, but
of perfect mind & memory, looking to mind the mortality &
approaching dissolution of my body, do make & declare
to be my last Will & Testament, And that I have committed
sent into the hands of Almighty God that good it without
doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive
some again. And as trusting such worldly goods as
hath pleased the Lord to bless me with, I dispose of them in the
following manner & form. And in the first place -

"I have & bequeath to each of my three Daughters viz Sarah, Abner
& Mary Lewis & Margaret Robinson the sum of Eight Shillings each
"I have & bequeath to my beloved son Thomas Walsh all my Iron
tools including my three mowing tools & all the best clothes together
with the best that I own belonging, & all the remaining Articles that
to me belongs, or that I have any right to. Exclusion of one son
more which I leave to John Walsh, son to my son Thomas &
to be equally divided between my two sons viz Thomas & William
Walsh after my funeral expenses & debts shall be all paid, then to
my last Will & Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 27th of November 1790.
