doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall  
serve again. And as touching such worldly goods as  
hath pleased the Lord to bless me with, I dispose of them in the  
following manner & form. And in the first place -

I leave & bequeath to each of my three Daughters viz Sarah, Anna  
& Mary Lewis & Margaret Robison the sum of eight shillings each  
I leave & bequeath to my beloved son Thomas Balch all my iron  
tools including my blacksmith tools & all the bed clothes together  
with the bed that I now lie on & all the remaining bed clothes the  
to me belongs, or that I have any right to exclusive of those  
more worth I leave to John Balch son to my son Thomas &  
equally divided between my two sons viz Thomas & William  
Balch after my funeral expenses & entablls are all paid. Also to  
my last will & testament, he witness I have cause to set my hand  
set this 27<sup>th</sup> day of November 1790.
