I Will all my real & personal Estate I am possessed of not above willed viz I Will all my
Children, bondable, school'd & bound'd unless they are come
of age off the whole here left to my sons before any division
is made to any of them viz an estimation is to be made when
the first Heir comes of age what will raise & school the rest equally to
him & if any of the sons dies without issue, I Will that his part be
divided equally amongst the rest of the sons viz the real estate
the personal is to be divided amongst the whole of the Children but
if the daughter dies then part is to be divided equally amongst
all the rest of the Legation, also I Will that out of the Vanders money
after my decease there be the first opportunity thirty pounds worth
of books bought for the benefit of my family & what is here
already to be divided equally amongst them all, & my proportion
yearly for the support of a Gospel Minister as if I were alive
agreeable to the wish of the Society viz the Episcopal Ministers
And lastly I do conclude, Robert Bigham & Thomas Green Esq
Executors of this my last Will & Testament & James Green & James
Bigham Trustees for my wife & Children, In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & seal this 10 day of August 1790
at New-Bethlehem & declared by the above named
John Bigham for & as his last Will and Testament
