In the name of God our saviour I John Hanes of the County of Mecklenburg
A State of North Carolina aforesaid in health & perfect mind & memory and
of this, to witness the inscrutability of my body deceased, & my infirmities
that all man is born to die & the uncertainty of this life, do make
you witness this my last Will & Testament; In the first place I recommend
my soul to God that gave it me & the merits of my Redeemer
In the next place my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian
like manner as my forebears hereafter as all men shall think fit
and appropriate bodily estate as it hath pleased God to bless me
with in life I dispose of in the manner & form following.

In the first place I leave unto my Son Walter Hanes 95 acres of land
containing two entries that he may go after the same place.

I leave unto my Son William Hanes 117 acres of land lying
on the head of the branch of Richardson's creek, in the third place.

I leave unto my Daughter Lydia her husband in money - to the
fourth place I leave unto my Daughter Anna Fox Hanes in money
In the sum of £100. to be paid on & after her marriage in the sum of £100.

In the tenth place I have ten to my Daughters Charity for Startings in Money
 & Household place I have ten to my Son Jas. Brown all my Land on
 the North side of Neches River creek, from the beginning line containing
 all the open land upland along up to the River down across
 to the eighth place I send unto Sarah my wife all my land lying
 on the South side of the Brown dam just west of the South side
 of Neches river creek bearing her wedlock and the land generally
 of land that I sent to my wife to begin & finally divided
 between my son Jas. Brown & Helen Brown at her desire I
 likewise send all my Stock goods & chattels to her & my wife
 bearing her wedlock & a messenger had them all my Goods &
 Stock & chattels to be equally divided between my above
 mentioned Sons & Daughters, my desire is that my wife & my
 son Jas. Brown be my trustees, the wife whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 22nd day of July 1, 1743
