22 In the name of God Amen, I John Carson being in a  
weakly State of body but of sound Mind & memory & knowing  
it is appointed for all men here to die, Do make & declare  
this my last will & Testament Viz. Commending my soul  
to God who gave it & my body to the Earth to be buried in  
a Christian manner, And establishing such worldly estate  
as God hath blessed me with in this life I give bequeath and  
dispose of in the following manner Viz. I give &  
bequeath to my loving wife Sally her Heirs & assigns forever  
three Negroes Viz. two boys & one girl, one boy named Sandy  
one named Sam & one girl named Pol. Item I give &  
bequeath to my beloved wife my black mare & black hearse  
I give & bequeath to my beloved wife all the money  
indebted from Abraham Stinson be it more or less, and all the  
money indebted me from James Hitchell be it less or more  
not exceeding one hundred & fifty Dollars. The above property  
to be valued by two indifferent persons & that same it lacks  
of two thousand Dollars. Together with the above mentioned  
monies, the balance to be made up out of what may be sold  
at Pandean. It is my further will & pleasure that my beloved  
wife have the living of the plantation during life I have  
now on. Item It is my further will & pleasure that my beloved

wife have all the household & kitchen furniture that belong to me  
 Item It is my further will & pleasure my beloved Aunt Sarah have  
 her maintenance off the plantation as mentioned in my Uncle  
 James Charters will Item It is my further will & pleasure  
 that my beloved wife hold all the stock that belong to me  
 Cattle Sheep & Hogs and all the grain on the plantation as  
 her own property, & that it be considered to the use of the  
 family as tho' I were living Item It is my further will  
 that my beloved wife hold all the farming utensils as her own  
 for the use of the family Item It is my will & pleasure that  
 my beloved brother James Carson have my saddle and all my  
 hunting apparel Item It is my further will & pleasure  
 that the land that belong to me in Tennessee not yet sold  
 be it sold as mine be equally divided amongst or between my  
 brother & sisters Item It is my further will & pleasure after  
 my wifes decease that the plantation I now live on be put  
 to publick sale and the money equally divided between  
 my brother & sisters their heirs assigns &c Item It is my further  
 will & pleasure that after the death of Aunt Sarah that four  
 Negroes viz one Negro woman named Rose one boy named Charles  
 one Mulatto girl named Eliza & one younger one named Kelly  
 be put to publick sale & the money equally divided among my  
 brother & sisters their heirs &c Item It is my further will &  
 pleasure that such property as is not willed in discharge  
 of as the Executors may think best for the advantage of my  
 wife & family put to publick sale or otherwise &  
 hereby revoking all former wills & gifts or bequests by  
 me made either in word or writing And lastly I do hereby  
 nominate constitute & appoint my Trusty friends Job  
 Cannon and James Sample to be my whole & sole Executors  
 of this my last will & Testament -
