will & Testament and do hereby bequeath by all as due to

I Will that my plantation situate as it is so well known
with & adjacent to the river of the North & the South, being
I think included - I Will that my son, the eldest & the
Child shall have the maintenance of the plantation
during her single life & her portion equal to my other two
daughters - I Will that my wife have the house & furniture
during her natural life -

I do bequeath to my son James Cathcart one Dollar

I do bequeath to my son John Cathcart one Dollar

I do bequeath to my daughter Sally Cathcart one Dollar

I do bequeath to my daughter Polly Cathcart one Dollar

I do bequeath that at the expiration of my wife or her widow
hood or natural life be sold & divided between my three young
est boys William & Robert & Newton & hereunto I set my hand &
seal this 10th day of April 1811

Test I do say my wife to be my Executor and my son James
Cathcart to be my other Executor
