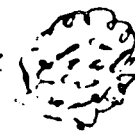

This fourth day of March in the year of our Lord 1788 I John Carreuth of Mecklenburg County in the State of N^o Carolina being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God, and calling to mind my Mortality & that it is appointed for men once to die, Do make this my last Will & Testament; first of recommending my soul unto the hands of God that gave it & my body to the earth to be Buried in Christian burial at the direction of my Executors hereafter named nothing doubting but to receive the same again at the General resurrection by the mighty power of God hoping thro' the merits & passion of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ to receive a full & free pardon of all my sins & to inherit everlasting life, And as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life

I give & bequeath & dispose of the same in the following manner & from my first of all that all those debt & duties that I owe to any person or persons be first & satisfied or contrived to be paid in convenient time by my Executors here after named -

Item I give & bequeath to my loving wife Mary my dwelling house excepting Pottys room two beds & then full furniture thereto belonging & the kitchen & what thereon is including pots & all vessels of cooking & bay mare her saddle & bridle three cows her own choosing five head of sheep & what she chooses of Hogs, her living during life in said House & off said plantation in a peaceable quiet manner a negro woman named Pender to be at her own disposal to her & her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Jane a negro woman named Phillis to her & her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth a negro woman named Agge to her & her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary a tract of land containing 320 acres known by the name of Millers Land & a negro woman named Juno to her & her heirs & assigns forever I also give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary in Room in my dwelling house to be seen, used & used by her during her widowhood -

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Eleanor a negro woman named Jean now in her possession to her & her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Grand Sons (my sons & their sons) five negroes named Dorcas & four to have their heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Son Luke to the plantation whereon I now live 700 acres my Wagon & all the Horses that is not herein bequeathed, plows & the things thereto belonging all plantation implements with the remaining stock of every kind my

Item I give & bequeath to my loving wife Mary my dwelling house excepting Pottys room in the back & then full furniture thereto belonging & the clothes & what thereon is including hats & all articles of wearing & buy more her saddle & bridle there for her own choosing five head of sheep & what the choicer of Hogs, her living during life in said House & off said plantation in a peaceable quiet manner & negro woman named Pender to be at her own disposal to her & her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Jane a negro woman named Phillis to her & her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth a negro woman named Agge to her & her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary a tract of land containing 320 acres known by the name of Millers Land & a negro woman named Juno to her & her heirs & assigns forever I also give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary in room in my dwelling house to be received & used by her during her widowhood -

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Eleanor a negro woman named Jenn now in her possession to her & her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I give & bequeath to my Grand Sons (my son's sons) two negroes named Dorcas & Sam to have them their heirs & assigns forever -

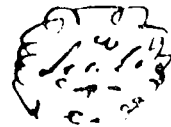

Item I name, nominate, constitute & appoint my loving wife Mary & my Son Archibald Executors of this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking & disannulling all former & other wills bequests, Devises and bequests by me in any

wise man to bequeath that or Demised heretofore, Ratifying and
confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament -

it may please divine providence by my present illness to remove me
from the Stage of Time, think it prudent in order to do justice to my
surviving Relations to make my last Will & Testament in manner
and form following

I Surrender my spirit into the hands of God who gave it hoping
that he will mercifully receive it, my body I commit to the Earth
believing & trusting that at the Resurrection I shall again possess
it; Of the worldly good with which it hath pleased a kind pro-
vidence to bless me, I dispose of them as follows Viz

To my son Joseph Curran I give & bequeath the house & open Lot
I possess in the Town of Charlotte & to Mary Curran the daughter
of my said son Joseph, I give & bequeath thirty pounds Current
Money of the State of N. Carolina to be kept at Interest by my
Executors until the said Mary shall come of age or be married
& that then the principal & Interest be delivered to her & also I
bequeath to my said Grand daughter Mary one portion for with
all the usual furniture thereto belonging - & to my two Grand
sons Alexander & John Curran I give & bequeath each five
pounds of ten pounds to be likewise kept at Interest for their
Use until they shall be of age. If one or more
of the above legacies shall die before they be come of age
I will that the respective Legacies by this Will devised to such
Legacies shall be paid to the surviving
