

The last Will & Testament of John Connor of Graham County North Carolina considering the uncertainty of this mortal life & being of sound mind & memory (blessed be Almighty God for the same) do make & publish this my last Will & Testament in witness & force following that is to say First I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Caroline Connor my negro woman Tyra negro girl Ellen & negro boy Charles Secondly To my Eldest daughter Mary Ann my negro boy Lucy Thirdly To my second daughter Lucy my negro woman Lora Fourthly To my Third daughter Emily Fifthly I will that all my stock in trade furniture &c in Charleston South Carolina be sold, also my stock in trade Lands & Tenements furniture of what name, Horses cattle & Hogs in Marshallburg County North Carolina be sold & after paying all my just debts due at my death together with other expenses, The balance to be equally divided between my said wife Caroline & my three daughters Mary Ann, Lucy & Emily share & share alike And Lastly I will & appoint my said wife Caroline Executor & my friend Thomas P. Dillon Executor of this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me made. In Witness I have hereunto set my hand & seal this third day of July, 1832.
