 my Negro boy Thirdly To my second daughter
Lucy my Negro woman Fourthly To my Third
daughter Emily ~~my~~ boy Sam & negro girl Nancy &
fifthly I will that all my stock in trade furniture &
 in Charleston South Carolina be sold, also my stock in
 Trade Lands & Tenements furniture of what name, Horses
 Cattle & Hogs in Wake County North Carolina be
 sold & after paying all my just debts due at my death
 together with other expenses, The balance to be equally
 divided between my said wife Caroline & my three
 daughters Mary Ann, Lucy & Emily share & share alike
 And lastly, I will & appoint my said wife Caroline
Executrix & my friend Thomas P. Dillon Executor of this
 my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all former
 Wills by me made. In Witness I have hereunto set my hand
 & seal this third day of July, 1832.
