of one hundred pounds of good English.

Item I will & beg earnestly my beloved wife Jacob Rogers. Eldest son of
the above said Christiane the sum of Five Pounds.

Item I will & beg earnestly any other person that might be in want
I am the sum of five Shillings £. 5. 0. mrs.

Item I will give to my son in law Edward Stetson with my beloved
wife Barbara book for her to have & enjoy, for ever all
that tract of land in the county of Landopon which I
now bear containing 134 acres with all the improvements thereon
And also all my right after I have & the same both in Law
& Equity to all and every part of the same in, and which
belongs to apportioned. And also further I will give
it beg earnestly unto my said beloved wife Barbara all the
remainder of my wife's goods & chattels £646 10s, upon and
my last estate and the same likewise.

And I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Barbara
book to be my whole & sole Executor of this my last will
& Testament, hereby revoking all former written gifts & legacies by
me made or done & left by me & giving away this & no other
to be my last will & Testament so far as may be
dated this the 28th of October 1782.

as his last will & Testament who in his presence in the presence

all that ever I did as makes & obtain this my last will
& Testament that is to say from, fully & just as all I can
possibly now say to God who gave it and my body
to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my
Executors where ever I shall, lawfully, goe and die
and have ye a full free to us, me & the heirs of
these are the following manner & terms (viz)

I will & begone make my beloved wife Barbara my Executrix of this

will & bequeath unto my beloved son Jacob Rogers, Eldest son of

the above named Christian the sum of Five Hunders.

I will & bequeath to any other son that might obtain birth by
law the sum of five Hunders & no more.

I will give Barbara in summer day next \$100.00 and my beloved
wife Barbara back to her son Jacob & his wife, for ever all
that real property consisting of land upon which of
new house containing 13y acres with all the improvements thereon
and also all my other little chattels & goods both in Law
& Equity to all with my rest of the sum in, am bequeath
belonging to apportioned — and also further I do give
to bequeath unto my said second wife Barbara all the
remainder of my wife Jacob & children, 46 H. in property inc
my first estate and the above bequeath.

And I do hereby appoint my said beloved wife Barbara
back to be my whole & sole Executor of this my last will
& Testament, hereby revoking all former wills, gifts & bequests by
me made or done & affixing a copy of this instrument to the same
to be my last will & Testament sealed with my hand and
dated this the 28th of October 1782.
