Do make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner and
form following to wit

I Will and desire that at my death, all & every species of
my Estate both real & personal be divided between my
Surviving Heirs agreeable to the Laws of this State, and that
my two friends John Kendrick & Hugh McDevell be and
I do hereby constitute the said John Kendrick and Hugh
McDevell to be the Sole Executors of this my last will,
and Testament, hereby declaring them & them only to be
my last — In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & Seal this 12th October A.D. 1805
