I John Doherty of the State of North Carolina & County of Wake County, being weak in body & in a very low state of Health, but of sound mind & memory, blessed be God for all his mercies, and calling to mind the mortality of my Body, that it is appointed for all men once to die; Do make this my last will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say first. I bequeath my body to decent burial suitable to my Station; and also all my lawful debts be discharged and fully paid. I Will & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Agnes one bed & furniture, one black mare, three Cows & calves & all my house hold furniture, six Sheep, Linnen wheel & all my hogs, together with all my farming implements, plow Harrow & Trappings &c and it is my further will & pleasure that my well beloved wife Agnes enjoy all the benefits & profits arising from the plantation now in on until my son James arrives to the age of Twenty one years & afterwards that he enjoy the third of the profits of the plantation together with the Mansion house & other necessary houses during his natural life -

Item

I Will & bequeath unto my well beloved son James Doherty the plantation whereon I now live, one black horse saddle & bridle & thirty pounds in cash, and also I Will that he pay unto his two Sisters Rose Ann & Mary Doherty the sum of Ten pounds each when he arrives to the age of Twenty five years -

I Will & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter Rose Ann Doherty one black Horse saddle & bridle, one bed & furniture two Cows & calves & one Linnen wheel -

I Will & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter Mary Doherty one mare & colt, one bed & furniture two cows & calves & one Linnen wheel and also if there should be any remainder of my estate after the discharge of my Debts & paying of said Bequeathments it be equally divided among my above named Children -

And for the true execution of this my last will & Testament I do subscribe & appoint my well beloved wife Agnes Doherty & my good & trusty friend Johⁿ Alexander, Jun^r & myself witnesses of these hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 20th day of May 1786

Body, that it is appointed for all men one to die; Do make this

to my Station; and also all my lawful debts to be discharged
and fully paid. I Will & bequeath unto my well beloved
wife Agness one bed & furniture, one black mare, three Cows

& all my hogs, together with all my farming implements, plow
Harrow & Fackings &c and it is my further Will & pleasure that
my well beloved wife Agness enjoy all the benefits & Profits
arising from the plantation I now live on untill my son Jo-
seph arrives to the age of Twenty one years & afterwards she to enjoy the
share of the profits of the plantation together with the Division
house & other necessary houses during her natural life.

Item

I Will & bequeath unto my well beloved son James Deharty the
plantation whereon I now live, one black horse saddle & bridle &
Thirty pounds in Cash, and also I Will that he pay unto his two
Sisters Susannah & Mary Deharty the sum of Ten pounds each
when he arrives to the age of Twenty five years.

I Will & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter Susannah
Deharty one black Horse saddle & bridle, one bed & furniture
two Cows & Calves & one Linnen wheel.

I Will & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter Mary Deharty
one Mare & Colt, one bed & furniture two Cows & Calves & one Linnen wheel
and also if there should be any remainder of my estate after the
discharge of my Debts & paying of said bequeathments it be equal-
ly divided among my above named Children.

And for the true Execution of this my last will & Testament I do
constitute & appoint my well beloved wife Agness Deharty & my
good & trusty friend Johⁿ Alexander, Jun^r Executors whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 20th day of May 1786
