I bequeath to my Brother William Doherty his Due sum one hundred dollars that is fifty dollars to each of them. I bequeath to my Brother James Doherty two dollars. To his son Francis Doherty fifty Dollars. I bequeath to my sister Elizabeth Dusen five dollars. I bequeath to my Brothers children Daniel Doherty to Rebecca fifty Dollars. I bequeath to his daughter Elizabeth Doherty one black mare. To his Daughter Hannah Doherty one bay Horse. To his Daughter Eleanor Doherty one lot of said black mare. I bequeath to my Brother Daniel Doherty all the rest of my Estate real & personal. I also appoint my Brother Daniel Doherty Executor of this my last will & Testament the witness I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 3^d day of May anno Dom. 1817
