Carolina, Being in sound mind & memory thank be to Almighty God for the same Do make & ordain this my last will & Testament in words & figures as follows that is to say. Item. It is my will that after my breath leaves my body that after a suitable intermission that they commit my body to the ground in a Christian manner. Item Tis my will that all my just debts be paid; and for the property that God has bestowed on me I give with in the following manner. Item. It is my will & pleasure that my stepson Samuel Gendall have all my plantation lying on the head of Grace Creek being in the same County & State aforesaid containing 14 Leins Black, James Hanes, Dungen Geesies, Robert Gamble Heirs & Samuel Gendall — Item It is my will that Jane Kerr have the use of the plantation for three years — Item. It is my will & pleasure that my Daughter Elizabeth have one Dollar of my estate — Item. It is my will & pleasure that Martha Gendall Robert daughter have my bed & Head & furniture. — Item. It is my will & pleasure that Anne Kerr have my corner cupboard — Lastly I hereby constitute & appoint John Mc'Call my Executor of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I the said John Pearson have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 2<sup>d</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord 1828  
and that was in presence of each other saw the above named John Pearson sign seal & acknowledge the above to be his last will & Testament signed in the presence of us
