Lord God 1798 I John Scott of Hertford County State of North Carolina  
being weak in body but of perfect mind & memory therefore do give unto God  
therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it  
is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain in this my last will  
& testament that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend  
my soul into the hands of God who gave it; and for my body I  
recommend it to the earth to be interred in a Christian like & decent  
manner at the discretion of mine executors nothing doubting but  
at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the  
mighty power of God; had as to my living such worldly estate where  
with it pleased God to bless me in this life I give claim & disposal of  
the same in the following manner & form —

I order my just debts all to be discharged as also my funeral expences  
I leave all my household property or furniture to my beloved wife  
Catherine Foard for use exclusively of all others during her life  
& to be disposed of by her at her death — Item I also leave the negro  
woman by name Charlotte & young Charlotte the child of her, —  
Item to my beloved wife Catherine Foard during her life & to be  
disposed of by her at her death as she sees fit — Item I also will  
to my beloved wife Catherine Foard Twenty bushel of wheat  
& twenty bushels of corn yearly to her for her proper use of the produce  
of the plantation or otherwise — Item I also will to my beloved  
wife Catherine one Sorrel horse three years old her saddle & bridle  
Item I also will to my beloved wife Catherine three cattle his  
choice of the stock — Item I also will unto my beloved wife Catherine  
four hundred pounds weight of Mason yearly for her use but four hundred  
pounds weight yearly — Item I also will unto my beloved wife Catherine  
one the one third part of the sheep that are on the place — — —  
Item I also will unto my beloved son Zebulon Foard one negro  
girl named Sylvie now in his possession and to his Heirs forever  
Item I also will unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth Morris  
& her Heirs forever one negro girl named Dinah now in his possession  
Item I also will my negro man named Will to my son Zebulon  
Foard & his Heirs forever to be disposed of to him after the death of that

is appointed for all men once to die. Do make & ordain in this my last will & testament that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it, and for my body I recommend it to the earth to be interred in a Christian like & decent manner at the discretion of mine executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God; And as touching such worldly estate where with it pleased God to bless me in this life, I give, devise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form —

I also will unto my beloved wife Catherine four hundred pounds weight of Bacon yearly for her use, and four hundred pounds weight yearly - Item. I also will unto my beloved wife Catherine the one third part of the Stock that are on the place - Item. I also will unto my beloved son Zebulon Foard one negro girl named Sylvia now in his possession and to his heirs forever - Item. I also will unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth Morris their heirs forever one negro girl named Dinah now in his possession - Item. I also will my negro man named Leffell to my son Zebulon Foard & his heirs, however taken up and sold to him after the death of that in the ground now & about to be buried in, is all gathered in and buried - Item. I also will my negro man named Jack to my daughter Elizabeth Morris their heirs forever, & to be delivered to her after the death of that in the ground now & about to be put in is all gathered in & buried

Item. I also will my negro boy named Lubbo to my son Zebulon for  
His Heirs forever - Item. I also will my negro girl named Dicy to my  
Daughter Elizabeth Harris Her Heirs forever - Item I also will my  
negro woman Phoebe to my daughter Elizabeth Harris Her Heirs  
forever - Item I also will that my land be equally divided (after  
my wife Catherine's decease) between my son Zebulon Board &  
My Daughter Elizabeth Harris & their Heirs, forever -  
Item. I also will that the remainder of the Stock in the two thirds  
be equally divided between my son Zebulon Board & Elizabeth  
Harris & their Heirs forever - Item. I also will that the remainder  
of the Cattle after my wifes part is taken out be equally divided  
between my son Zebulon & my Daughter Elizabeth & their Heirs forever  
Item. I also will that after this present Crop is gathered in & stored  
my Horse be equally divided between my son Zebulon and my  
Daughter Elizabeth and their Heirs forever -

And I hereby make & Ordain James Wilson Board & William Robb  
Snd Executors of this my last Will & Testament. In witness  
whereof I the said John Board have to this my last Will and  
Testament set my hand & seal the day & year above written  
Signed, sealed, published & declared by the said  
John Board the Testator as his last Will & Testament  
in the presence of us who were present at the  
time of signing & sealing thereof -
