presently constitute & appoint my brother in law Thomas Moore
& Stephen Alexander Green Executors of this my last will & Testament
and Guardians for my Children, and by them presently to be done
make void & disannul all former Wills & Testaments by me
hereof made, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & affixed my seal this 19th day of March A.D. 1817.

5th I will & request that my Executors Do Emancipate & set free my Negro man Benjamin & my black woman Rose and her children if any after this date, and for their support I will to them that part of land lying on the south west side of the great road to the Creek bearing Andrew Webbers land house & two lots one place & utensils to be their right property and I do appoint William Louis, Joseph Webber & Thomas Miller to execute this my last will & Testament and I do hereby utterly renounce all wills & Testaments by me made. & I do appoint & declare this my last will & Testament signed & sealed this 19th of April 1820 in the presence of us

I John Fox being at present in my perfect senses but considering the uncertainty of my remaining in this world long; Do this day make the following disposition of my worldly estate viz I give & bequeath all that I possess or may have a right to that is my Negro boy Larkin now with me, all my interest in the Trust of Land in Braeage County State of Virginia whereon my father formerly lived which he received by my deceased Mother, all my interest in my Grand mother Mrs Mary Jones down, all my interest in the several tracts of Land in the State of Kentucky which I claim by my late deceased Mother, all my interest in the Estate of my late Deceased Aunt Polly Fox as left to me in her last will, together with every thing else both real & personal to which I may be entitled. To my dear Brother Dr C. Stephen Fox to him & his heirs forever.
