 Viz^t It is my will that after named Executors should pay all my just debts. — 2^d It is my will & desire, that my Executors Deliver to my Daughter Polly one good feather bed two quilts 2 Blankets, 2 Sheets & a bolster & 2 Sheets with their cases & a Spinning wheel. — 3^d It is my will & desire that all the residue of my Estate not herein specially devised should be sold immediately after my decease & after paying all my just debts, the surplus to be equally divided between my three Children Abraham, Polly & John. — 4th It is my will & desire that my after named Executors should lend out my two sons Abraham & John to learn some good Trade
 5th I hereby appoint my friends Jacob Hoxworth & William Litch Executors to this my last Will, In Testimony whereof I have set my hand & seal this 12th day of January 1816
