 mind & memory think it to be my duty & desiring to signify the last
 will of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
 die make constitute & ordain this my last Will & Testament, that
 to say Presumptively I give & bequeath my soul into
 the hand of Almighty God who gave it & my body to the earth to be
 buried in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Exors
 nothing relating but I shall receive the same again at the general
 Resurrection thro' the mighty power of God, and trusting that
 mercifully God will reward it he has pleased God to bless me in this
 life I give & bequeath unto my dear & beloved wife Margaret
 one equal third part of my Estate after the payment of all just debts
 & my funeral charges & also she shall have the privilege of my place
 & tenement I now live on to keepy the same so long as she shall live or
 it out of repair which Privilege she shall enjoy if she remains
 a widow until my son John George shall come to the age of twenty
 one years & no longer, Also my wife Margaret shall have the use of
 my Gray horse to ride & otherwise during the time she remains
 a widow. - I give & bequeath unto my son John George the place
 & tenement of Land I now live on to which he shall receive into, poss-

When he shall arrive to the age of Twenty two years also he shall have all
 my Prime Tools provided he will learn the Prime Trade & Also he shall
 have my Bible & an other called The Monthly Monitor & a sermon book
 called Freedom's Works — I give & bequeath unto my daughter Catha-
 rine one Equal half of the surplus of my Estate after the above legacies
 are deducted also a book set forth by Mr Benjamin Smallkins —
 I give & bequeath to my daughter Margaret the remainder of my Estate as
 an Equal share with her sister above mentioned & also a book called
 the heavenly Garden of Ephraim — And I do hereby constitute &
 appoint Abraham Dittmerman & John Whitham Executors of this
 my last Will & Testament & my Executors are required not to make
 sale of my moveable Estate that is to be divided for the Term of three years
 & provided my Executors shall find it necessary to make some repairs
 on the plantation then the expense of the same shall be taken out
 of my Estate before any divide is made, and my Executors shall take
 charge of my Children & take particular care of their Education & deduct
 the expense of the same out of my undivided Estate & when my son John
 George shall arrive to the age of Eighteen years my Executors shall put him
 apprentice a trade such as he shall choose & provided he shall not learn
 the Prime Trade then my Executors shall make sale of the books & publish-
 ings & the price thereof shall be equally divided between my wife &
 my three Children each having a like share (my hand & excelsior)
 which is to be given to my son John George over & above his share & also
 a few Aday & a fanning law. And I do hereby revoke, Disannul &
 make void all other Wills, Ratifying & confirming this & no other
 to be my last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
