spirit mind & memory. Do make & ordain this my last Will and
testament. That is to say principally & first of all, I give my soul unto
God who gave it, nothing doubting but I shall receive the same again
at the general resurrection. & my body I allow to be buried in a
decent manner at the discretion of my executors, and as it hath pleased
God as it hath pleased god to bless me with, I dispose of them in the
following manner viz - Item. I give & bequeath to my dear and
loving wife Sarah the one third of all my estate, after all the just
demands against the same is satisfied - Item. I will & bequeath
unto my well beloved son anders the other two thirds of the whole estate
Item. I will & bequeath unto my well beloved son before the remaining
one third of all my estate - Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter
Sarah Ann McRae an odd three year old boy known by the name
of Nipper. And provided it please god to remove by death either
of my above mentioned sons, I will & allow the survivor to enjoy
a part of the estate, & provided they both die, I will & allow
my well beloved wife to enjoy the whole of my said estate.

now intituled in the Service of His province in order to quell the
Rebel & Rebellion now raised against the Government by the

God to call me out of this life, either by the hands of the common
enemy, or by divine providence, Do therefore make & bestow
& no other to be my last Will & Testament, testomy worldly estate
wherever the Lord has been pleased to bless me with, I will do
the greatest in manner & form following that is to say
In nomine. I will that my beloved wife Barbara have possession
my dwelling house & plantation during her widowhood in bed
& support her & three children now living with her until they
marry or come of age according to the different sex & in case my
said wife should marry I will that she have one third part of
lands or one third part of the next yearly profits during her life
On base of her death or her wife marriage again I will that my
executors do sell & dispose of my land in the best manner they can
& that the money arising from the sale to be equally to be divided
between my children in general by equal portions first
to my son John who is a Cripple to whom I give five pounds
more than any of the rest, & in order to pay my just debts & in
