being very sick & weak, but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given
unto God, calling into mind the mortality of my body & knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make & declare this my
last will & Testament, that is to say principally & first of all I give &
recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that give it
& my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent
Christian manner, nothing doubting but at the general
Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the power of
God, And as touching such Worldly Estate whereunto it has
pleased God to bless me in this life I give & dispose of the same
to Sarah Hargrove my beloved wife to be freely enjoyed by her
during her life & after her decease to fall to my son Benjamin
Hargrove & his Heirs forever. In Witness whereof I have written
my hand & seal this 26th day of August 1795
