Verieat H. Breide & my Daughter in law Lucinda Henderson
Lastly I do hereby nominate my Trusty friends Andrew Henderson
& Gabriel Alexander Executors of this my last Will & Testament

In the name of God Amen, I John Harvey of the County of Mitchell
& State of N. Carolina, being Weak in body but of a perfect mind and
knowing & calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die, I do hereby constitute & appoint
as my last Will & Testament in the manner & form as follows. And
first of all I recommend my body to the Earth to be buried in a decent
Christian like manner at the discretion of my wife & children. I do
to my worldly Estate wherein it hath pleased God to bless me with

in the life I give & dispose of the same in the following manner
 I form. First of all it is my will that all my lawfull debts may
 be paid, & it is my will that the following property shall be sold
 at public sale to discharge said debts viz sixty acre joining
 John Winer, two Waggons with the hind gears & sixty acre joining
 Daniel Robinson, & three head of horses, & the Mill & all the Vessels be-
 longing to said Mill with all my hogs Except one sow & pig, I allow
 to my wife & all my Cattle Except one Chance Cow & allow to my wife
 & likewise allow two years to be sold, I allow them with all
 my book accounts to go to pay my debts, & if there be any Re-
 mainder after my debts is paid, I allow my Daughter Susan
 to have ten Dollars to purchase her a Saddle & then the Remain-
 der to be equally divided between her & all the remainder of all my
 Children allowing my wife to have an equal part with them
 And further it is my will that all my part that is coming to me
 at my Mothers death shall be Equally divided among my wife
 & Children, & further it is my will & pleasure that my beloved
 wife Elizabeth shall have all my household & Kitchen furniture
 of every kind, & further it is my will that my wife Elizabeth shall
 have one young brown horse & one black Colt I bought from Will-
 Prior to work the plantation with, together with two pair of Gen-
 tle plows & the hoes & whether it is my desire that my wife
 Elizabeth shall have the plantation I now live on during her
 widowhood to raise my Children & school them, & if my wife
 should marry, I allow her but the one third of the Land & that only
 for her life time & if my wife marry I allow the children to
 have the two thirds of the plantation at her marriage & at her
 death I allow the land to be equally divided among all my Children
 & since I do hereby constitute & appoint my two sons Nathan &
 Solomon to be my sole Executors to this my last will & Testament
 In testifying this & no other to be my last will & Testament, & further
 it is my will that my wife shall allow her Grand daughter Susan
 & her Caroline Mackey to have ten Dollars - In test & witness whereof
 I said John Mackey said hath hereunto set his hand & affixed my seal
 This 20 day of February in the year of our Lord 1821.
