(I do constitute & ordain Mary Harkness my wife & my son
Thomas & my sole Executors of this my last will & testament
Revoke & disannul all former Testaments confirming this
& no other to be my last will & testament. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 16th day
of July in the year of our Lord 1807 and 32 of our Inde-
pendence A.D. I do impower the executors to make a
Sufficient to my person for the funds
