

during her widowhood or to my daughters marriage or coming of age to be sold at her marriage or death or my Daughter Margerit's marriage or coming of age which ever shall first happen the half of the plantation bequeathed to my wife to be Excepted & kept back from her for my son James, The remainder to be sold & equally divided between my two Daughters Hannah Wiley & Margerit. Likewise if there be any Remainder of my Estate not bequeathed, I do allow it to be equally divided between my two youngest Daughters Hannah Wiley & Margerit. I do further allow if my wife should marry or depart this life before my two youngest Daughters marriage or coming of age that my two daughters Hannah Wiley & Margerit go to what ever place they make choice of in case my Executors think their choice is best.

I do further constitute & appoint my beloved wife Margerit & my two sons Ebenezer Harris & John Harris to be my Executors of this my last Will & Testament given under my hand & Seal the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1794

I John Hunter of Merkleburg County & State of N<sup>o</sup> Carolina, being of sound & perfect mind & memory do hereby Do this 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1798 make & publish this my last Will & Testament in Manner & form following, that is to say First I will that all my Just Debts be honestly & Lawfully paid by my Executors herein after named I bequeath & will to my loving Mother Mary Hunter all that estate left her by the last Will & Testament of my Father John Hunter Dec<sup>d</sup> with the whole further Priviledges she may stand in need of in my mention herein during the Term of her natural life also one horse named Philip — Item I Will & bequeath to my brother Robert Hunter Ten dollars — Item I Will & bequeath to Mary Wiley my sister my sister & wife to James Grealy Ten Dollars — Item I bequeath to my sister Rachel Ch<sup>o</sup> Neely & wife to Andrew Wickely Ten Dollars — Item I bequeath to Rebecca Harris my sister & James Harris wife Ten Dollars — Item I bequeath my sister Martha Harris & wife of John Harris Ten dollars —

Item, I bequeath to my Nephew John Moore Harris son of John Harris a Rifle Gun marked on the thousand plate thus J.B. —

Item, I bequeath to my Nephew John Hunter Harris as son of James Harris a rifle gun marked on the Chick plate thus J.H. —

Item, I bequeath to my Apprentice boy James Wilson the use & benefit of my Cooper Shop during the term of my Mother's natural life & over & above what she gave or gave him by Indenture I have been all my Cooper Tools & Carpenter Tools & Board Ax & falling ax and one Horse named Buck also one mans saddle & one bridle also all wearing Apparel, and ten pounds in money —

Item I will that all the remainder of my houses & neat Cattle sheep and Hogs with all coming utensils one Still & all vessels belonging to her with a quantity of Whiskey, one loom & furnishings, Spinning tools with all the grain in the ground except so much as may be necessary to support my Mother at the discretion of my Executors also all grain that may be on hand at my Decease with all other Things that is to me belonging or Appertaining that is not mentioned in the former part of this Will, also my Waggon Cart & Gears allowing my Brother Robert to get his part, in them according to my Fathers will as him & my Executors & the other Legales can agree; all to be valued or sold & all the Valuations or price to be equally divided & my Brother's Children male & female each to get a Share & also my Mother to get an Equal Share with the above mentioned children of what is to be Valued or sold —

And I hereby make & ordain my true Trusty friends Hugh Peck & James Tazert Executors of this my last Will & Testament, In witness whereof I the said John Hunter have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand & seal this day & year first above written signed sealed published & declared by the said John Hunter the Testator as his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing & sealing thereof
