mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die, Do make & declare this my last will & Testament, the first of my
bequests, & first of all I give & bequeath my soul into the hands
of Almighty God that give it to be disposed of at his pleasure, &
my body I commend to the earth to be buried in a decent manner
at the discretion of my Executors — And as touching such worldly
estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life
I give & bequeath & dispose of the same in the following manner
I give viz I give & bequeath unto my dear wife & daughter my dear
beloved wife the plantation I now live on abiding, her natural
clothes & wearing her household & the two big mares the black one

and the bay I allow to be kept on the plantation for the support
of the family during my wife's widowhood, & at her decease
it is my will that the black man be sold for the use of the children
the bay made with three acres one bed & furniture the shelf board
& saddle & one school, I give & bequeath to my wife, & in case
the land & live on I allow to be sold by my Executors at my
death or marriage, in the advantage of my children, the negro
woman & child I allow to be kept on the plantation for to help
to raise the children as long as she proves obedient & sub. with
to her Mistress's commands & in case she proves disobedient I
leave it to the discretion of my Executors to manage with her
as they may then think proper, I give & bequeath unto my
beloved daughter Tarissa one bed & furniture, And my land
lying on Rocky Point, I allow it to be left in the hands of my
Executors to manage with it as may appear most advantageous
to my children, and the remaining part of my perishable pro-
perty I allow my Executors to make a valuable sell, & all my profits
I allow or the money arising from the same to be equally divided
amongst all my children except the above mentioned property
which I have particularly bequeathed to my wife & daughter
Tarissa — In the first place I allow all my last Ditties to be paid
And I now do hereby constitute & appoint Margaret Hunter
wife & my Brother in law Nathan are to be my sole Executors;
