tance thro' Christ's merits & Righteousness & that I will that all my
lawful debts be paid — Next I will & appoint that all my moveable
estate remain in the hands & under the care of my wife in order to
Acquire, Support & maintain my four youngest children viz John
Samuel, Sarah & Daniel & that my wife have for herself one third
part of all my moveable estate & that I bequeath if my wife & children
shall by their industry pay for this Tract of Land on which I live that
then when my youngest son or child is come to age of Twenty one years
that then said land & improvements shall be valued by three men
by them chosen for that purpose & its price or value Equally divided
amongst my wife & four children as above ~~mentioned~~ named
& that any one of my children as above mentioned may purchase it & pay
the rest three share or otherwise it must be sold & the money arising
divided as above said, but if the Land is not paid for I appoint
that it be sold at the discretion of my Executors I also leave unto
Alexander & James Hutchinson my two eldest sons ten shillings
a piece — I also make & appoint Sarah Hutchinson my true &
loving wife & James Boyce in whose fidelity I trust my true &
lawful Executors of this my last Will & Testament, In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 17th day of
October in the Year of our Lord 1776 —

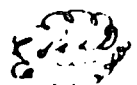
